AVOID THESE!

Dahlia
Hollyhock
Canna
Zinnia
Sunflower – *Helianthus annuus*
Gladiolus

Perennials and Vines – Clematis, Virginia Creeper -*Parthenocissus quinquefolia*, Morning Glory – *Ipomoea purpurea*, Roses, Hibiscus, Common Mallow – *Malva rotundiflora*, Evening Primrose-*Oenothera biennis*, Cardinal Flower – *Lobelia cardinalis*, Peony

Vegetables & Fruits – Asparagus, Grapes- *Vitis* spp., Rhubarb, Red Raspberry, Sweet Corn, Soybean

Plants that Japanese Beetles Don't Like



USE THESE!

Ageratum
Dusty Miller
Begonia
California Poppy – *Eschscholzia californica*
Impatiens
Lantana
Moss Rose – *Portulaca grandiflora*
Nasturtium
Violet, Pansy – *Viola* spp

Perennials – Columbine, Coreopsis, Larkspur, Foxglove, Coral Bells -*Heuchera*, Hosta, Forget-Me-Not – *Myosotis* spp, Poppy, Sedum

Geraniums have been said to be a “Fatal Attraction” – Beetles eat the blossoms, get dizzy, fall down and allow you to dispose of them very easily. Use them as a “trap” plant.
